# **Whitehouse Admissions Policy**

**Whitehouse is a setting for children with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties. Engaging, protecting and teaching 'our children' must be the starting point for all policies. This policy must be read in conjunction with our Safeguarding policy.**

## **Introduction**

Whitehouse admits children who have been permanently excluded from Primary schools in Hull and surrounding areas. Pupils may also be admitted for supported placements, by arrangement with parents/carers and mainstream schools.

We are an inclusive service, our aim is to reintegrate pupils successfully back into mainstream education (following a 6 week assessment place) or to signpost to the Special Educational Needs team (SEN) for an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP).

Excluded children are admitted on the sixth school day after exclusion from their mainstream school.

## **Re-integration**

We strive to re-integrate excluded pupils back into a mainstream school within six weeks. Parents/carers are supported in choosing a school by the Local Authority's Fair Access Panel.

## **Monitoring and review**

This policy will be monitored by the Local Governing Board.

The policy will be reviewed every two years, or earlier in the light of any change in circumstances.
